Crime Stoppers of Mesa County needs your help to identify the suspect involved in a theft.

Shortly after 6:00 p.m. on Tuesday, February 11<sup>th</sup>, a male entered Barnes & Noble located at 2451 Patterson Road. While inside, the male stacked several sets of Legos near the emergency exit door inside the business then left the store. A short time later, he returned to the stacked Legos, placed them inside a black plastic bag, and exited the business through the emergency door. The total estimated property loss is over \$1,200.

Security cameras captured a White male with a trimmed beard and short brown hair. He was last seen wearing black pants with a black sweater which had a white stripe across the center and white tennis shoes.
